## Call for Applications: Shape the Future of the ACMS Bulletin

### WHY JOIN THE EDITORIAL BOARD?

Serving on the Editorial Board is a meaningful way to share your voice and expertise with the medical community. Members help shape the Bulletin's themes and direction, review and edit submissions, recruit contributors, and occasionally author original pieces. In doing so, they amplify their colleagues' perspectives and highlight issues that matter to physicians and patients across Allegheny County.

### COMMITMENT & TERMS

- **Medical Editor (Chair):** Three-year renewable term (maximum six years), with responsibility for overall editorial vision and content approval.
- **Editorial Board Members:** Three-year renewable term (maximum six years), contributing editorial review, topic guidance, and occasional authorship.
- **Time Requirement:** At least two meetings per year (virtual or in-person), plus light review/input around quarterly editorial deadlines. Members are expected to contribute or review at least one article annually.
