Who can use Marit Health?

Marit Health is available to all physicians and advanced practice providers.

Is there a cost to participate?

At the time of this notice, Marit Health indicates access for clinicians is free. Participation is voluntary. Subscribers unlock a large dataset of real salaries with no subscription cost.

How reliable is the data?

The data on Marit Health is **self-reported by clinicians** and may vary in completeness or accuracy. Members should interpret the information in context and consider using multiple data sources when evaluating compensation.

Is my information private?

Marit Health states that submitted data is anonymized. Members are encouraged to independently review the platform's privacy policy and terms of use to understand how data is collected, stored, and potentially used.

Takeaways to Remember -

- It's free and clinician-focused
- Data is *self-reported* (may not be comprehensive)
- Users should read privacy terms before sharing sensitive information
- It *should not replace* professional compensation surveys for formal negotiation benchmarking
